

Jammie Thomas-Rasset, a central Minnesota woman found guilty of "sharing" 24 songs over the Internet, will begin preparing for another trial to determine new damages. Both the Record Industry and Thomas-Rasset rejected the latest settlement offer. This will be the third time this case, dating back to 2006, will see trial in a federal courtroom in Minnesota. Last year, a federal jury ruled Thomas-Rasset, a mother of four from Brainerd, willfully violated the copyrights on 24 songs. She was ordered to pay \$1.92 million in damages, or \$80k per song. Last week, Chief U.S. District Judge Michael Davis reduced the verdict to \$54k, calling the jury's penalty "monstrous and shocking." In a letter to Thomas-Rasset's attorneys, lawyers for the RIAA said they would consider accepting less than the jury's \$1.92 million award, offering a different option: \$25k, which would go to a charity for struggling musicians. Joe Sibley, an attorney for Thomas-Rasset, said his client would not settle. "Jammie is not going to agree to pay any amount of money to them," adding that it doesn't matter to Thomas-Rasset if the damages are \$25k or \$1.92 million. "For her, it's all the same. She just doesn't have the money to pay any of those, and it would be financially ruinous."

It's been a tough winter for radio stations across the country, damaging facilities and knocking stations off the air. In Bismarck, ND, **Connoisseur Media** Adult Hits KKBO was knocked off Sunday when "a huge chunk of ice fell from the top of the tower...and crashed through the roof of the transmitter building." The station continues to stream online. Crosstown, **Clear Channel** is at reduced power due to ice and snow. In Watertown, SD, **Northwest Broadcasters** is reporting that an 820-foot tower holding the antennas of **Three Eagles** Country KSDR-FM, Hot AC KIXX and Classic Hits KKSD/Watertown fell due to ice.

CBS News WBBM-AM and Sports WSCR-AM/Chicago Operations Director **Drew Hayes** crosses the street, returning to **Citadel** Talk WLS-AM/Chicago in the same capacity, effective February 1. Hayes, who replaces **Bob Shomper**, was PD at WLS in 1989-96 before moving to

ESPN Radio and KABC-AM/Los Angeles. He also hosted at the old WMAQ-AM/Chicago and oversaw Talk WCKG for CBS. Afternoon host **Roe Conn**, who was first hired at WLS by Hayes, called him "one of the great architects of modern Talk radio. I couldn't be more thrilled that we're able to get the band back together."

Citadel Talk WLS-AM/Chicago staged a debate between the Republican candidates for Governor of Illinois this Wednesday. Afternoon hosts Roe Conn and Cisco Cotto moderated. Candidates Adam Andrzejewski, Bill Brady, Kirk Dillard, Dan Proft and Jim Ryan fielded questions from Conn and Cotto, including suggestions from listeners.

Bankruptcy Court granted **Tribune Co.** the right to pay out \$45.6 million in bonuses to a group of 720 managers and executives. Judge **Kevin Carey** approved the bonus pool with the Washington-Baltimore chapter of the **Newspaper Guild** and the trustee objecting. Tribune argued that the bonuses are necessary for morale and the union complained that the bonuses were excessive and far above the normal percentage of cash flow. *Comment: Count us as one of the millions of people who become apoplectic when a company proposes bonuses for executives who've led that same company into bankruptcy. We know some of the execs for whom the bonuses are destined and to a person, they are extremely talented and dedicated professionals worthy of generous compensation. But for cryin' out loud, lead the company OUT of bankruptcy and THEN be presented with a bonus. And we wonder why the American public distrusts big business so much. – TK*


