

Konrad, who was wearing a helmet, hit a mattress on Interstate 94 in St. Paul and was thrown from his bike. The crash happened yesterday (3/18) about 6p on eastbound I-94. The



Tribune CEO Randy Michaels held a closed door meeting with his Talk WGN-AM/Chicago news staff this week to discuss who leaked the "newspeak" banned-words list to Vocalo.org's **Robert Feder**. Feder's source told him that Michaels asked staffers about leaks, "What do you think should happen to people who do that?" Michaels, allegedly, directed his disapproval to News Director **Charlie Meyerson** for his handling of the memo. Michaels and Feder have exchanged barbs with Michaels calling Feder an "out-of-work blogger" with Feder responding that he is being paid and had turned down an offer from Tribune's own **Chicago Now** website.

Clear Channel Top 40 WLDI/West Palm Beach was kicked out of **Roger Dean Stadium**, the spring training facility for the **St. Louis Cardinals**, for a "tasteless" stunt. The station's morning show set up a stand outside the stadium, urging listeners to throw "steroid darts" at a life-sized cutout of **Mark McGuire**, the new Cardinals batting coach who recently admitted taking steroids during his playing days. "Mark McGuire is a partner on our team. I'm not going to exploit the guy," St. Louis GM **Joe Pinto** said. "My issue was they were doing something stupid on our property. It wasn't right. It was tasteless." WLDI morning man **Kevin Rolston** responded, "It was not done to be mean-spirited. It was done on a topical baseball issue as a way to give tickets away. Our point is, I don't think many people are past it, even after the apology he gave, unless they're blinded by being diehard Cardinals fans."

Congrats to the winners of the **Colorado Broadcasters Association Awards Ceremony: Regent** Country KUAD/Ft. Collins won 'Best Morning Show,' 'Best Midday Show,' 'Best Station Entertainment Personality,' 'Best Sales Event or Live Remote,' and 'Station of the Year.' **Rocky Mountain Radio** Country KSKE/Eagle received the Medium Market awards for 'Best Morning Show,' and 'Station Entertainment Personality.' Also for Medium Markets: **Cherry Creek Radio** Country KKXK/Montrose received awards for 'Best News Feature Report or Series,' and 'Best Single Event News Coverage.' **Lincoln Financial** Country KYGO/Denver won two Metro Market awards for 'Best Morning Show' and 'Best Station Entertainment Personality.'

National Public Radio is putting \$160 million in tax-exempt fixed rate bonds on the market. The municipal bonds, graded AA- by **Standard and Poor's** and Aa3 by **Moody's Investor Service**, are intended to finance construction of its new HQ in D.C. Construction is planned to start later this year with completion set for 2013.

The **Detroit Sports Broadcasters Association** named its new Lifetime Contribution Award after former **Detroit Tigers** broadcaster **Ernie Harwell**. Harwell will be the first winner of the award, which is being given to broadcasters who contributed their work to the betterment of sports broadcasting.

Midwest Communications acquires **Rubber City Radio's** four station FM cluster in Lansing, MI for an undisclosed amount. The stations include: Active Rock WJXQ, Smooth Jazz WJZL, Classic Hits WQTX and Alternative WVIC. Midwest now owns 47 radio properties, including Michigan clusters in the Kalamazoo and Grand Rapids markets.

Clear Channel Top 40 KDWB/Minneapolis longtime morning guy **Dave Ryan** now has a full-time channel on the **iHeartRadio** app. (Download by <u>Clicking Here</u>) "Our listeners wanted more Dave and thanks to iHeartRadio, they've got him 24/7," KDWB PD **Rob Morris** said. "This has to be the biggest moment in mobile device history since the 'Pink Panther' ringtone!" Ryan exclaimed.

Midwest Family Active Rock WJJO/Madison, WI APD/MD/Middayer **Blake Patton** announces his retirement from FT radio after 35 years. "The time has come for me to take my headphones and retreat to my studio at home," Blake said. "May 14th, 2010 will be my last day on-air at WJJO. I'm retiring from full-time radio. I've had a glorious ride over the last 35 years. I've done start-ups, turnarounds, overnights, mornings, nights and everything in between. I could write a book...and maybe I will...but the time to leave full-time is now." Patton plans to concentrate on his at-home voice business.

Former Adult Standards KCHA-AM/Charles City, IA Station Manager/ Morning host **Scott Lanenga** is running for the **IPWA State Senate**. Lanenga is running as a Republican and challenging incumbent Democrat **Amanda Ragan** for the District 7 seat.


